PCAB Meeting Minutes October 17th 2024

Enrichment Offer (CMA)

- CMA presented current enrichment offer and updated HT2 offer.
- CMA gave details of the planning process of enrichment and provided an example planning document for upcoming year 7 enrichment fayre.
- CMA provided rationale behind launching HT2 offer with year 7 prior to full launch during tutor time (y8 & y9)
- Parents highlighted the strength of the enrichment offer and compares very favourably against other schools.
- Parents raised the possibility of recording enrichment clubs and providing an online platform for students to access enrichment content at home.
- Parents raised disappointment of year 10 currently missing out on enrichment offer. MST raised the rationale behind the year 10 plan and continued high performance in securing outcomes.

Student Leadership (LGE)

- LGE presented current picture of student leadership within the academy.
- LGE introduced the student leadership booklet/program.
- Parents very positive about student leadership and the opportunities given to students.
- Clearly thought out and well planned program that supports students to develop skills which will benefit them beyond the classroom.

Anti-Bullying (MST)

- MST presented areas in which he wanted parental feedback.
- Parents complimentary regarding how issues were dealt with by MST & team.
- Consistency of the application of outcomes was raised by parents and MST discussed that Anti-bullying was now part of the regular Pastoral meeting agenda.
- MST discussed pastoral structure and the impact this has on ensuring consistency across the team.
- MST discussed the tracking of bullying incidents and parents were happy with the robust nature of the tracking system. Parents asked about consequences and MST gave updates on how incidents are dealt with.
- Wake up Wednesday was discussed as a possible support mechanism.

- Contacts with the police were also discussed and raised avenues for support.
