### **Paris 2026**

Sir Thomas Wharton Academy are extremely excited to offer your child the enrichment opportunity to be part of our Paris trip 2026. This 4-day visit includes 3 nights half board; lunches will need to be purchased by students. The visit is expected to depart Sir Thomas Wharton Academy on Saturday 28 March returning to the academy on Tuesday 31 March 2026.

Although not a compulsory part of the curriculum, this trip will provide students an opportunity to explore Paris and its spectacular sights.

### **Example Itinerary**

#### **Day 1**

Morning departure from school  
Early afternoon ferry crossing  
Onward journey to the accommodation  
Evening meal en route - Le Mystère Du Buffet  
Arrive at the accommodation  
Check in to rooms  
Overnight stay

#### **Day 2**

Breakfast at accommodation  
Depart to Stade de France  
Enjoy a stadium tour at Stade de France, followed by time in the gift store  
Depart for River Cruise  
Sightseeing cruise on the River Seine (opportunity to eat purchased lunches)  
Proceed on foot to the Eiffel Tower for a self-led visit  
Depart to the Arc de Triomphe  
Opportunity to view the Arc de Triomphe  
Evening meal at Chez Eugene  
Return to the accommodation  
Overnight stay

#### **Day 3**

Breakfast at accommodation  
Depart to Disneyland Paris  
Full day visit to Disneyland Paris  
Lunch opportunities within the parks / village  
Evening meal in the park purchased with meal voucher  
Fireworks display



Return to the accommodation  
Overnight stay

#### **Day 4**

Breakfast at accommodation  
Room inspections and check out  
Board the coach and depart to Calais  
Afternoon ferry crossing  
Arrive in Dover and continue journey toward school  
Arrive back at school

The total cost of the visit is £675.00, this is fully inclusive of all travel, excursions and half board accommodation. Additional costs to consider will be money for lunches, gifts and souvenirs.

You will be able to make the first initial non-refundable deposit of £110 via ParentPay to secure your child's place. The deposit must be paid by Monday 17 November 2025 or the place will be reallocated to another student.

Payment should be made via the ParentPay facility. If you are unable to access to ParentPay and require a barcoded letter to pay at a PayPoint, please email [admin@stwacademy.com](mailto:admin@stwacademy.com) and a letter will be printed for the student to collect from Reception. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact [admin@stwacademy.com](mailto:admin@stwacademy.com) and a member of staff will contact you to discuss options in which we may be able to offer support.

Please note that if there are insufficient students to make this visit viable, then it will be cancelled and a full refund will be issued.

Please also note that giving consent and making payment, does not automatically guarantee the student's participation in the visit. This is dependent on student behaviour, attendance and investment.

By making the initial payment, you are **giving consent for your child** to take part on this visit and **agreeing to the non-refundable payment plan** below:

- Initial payment: £110 due Monday 17 November 2025
- Interim payment 1: £142 due Monday 15 December 2025
- Interim payment 2: £141 due Monday 12 January 2026
- Interim payment 3: £141 due Monday 9 February 2026
- Interim payment 4: £141 due Monday 9 March 2026
