Iceland Trip 2027

I am extremely excited to offer your child the enrichment opportunity of being part of our Iceland Trip 2027. The 5-day visit includes 4 nights full board, on the go lunches will be provided whilst visiting the must-see attractions. The visit is expected to depart Sir Thomas Wharton Academy on Monday 12 July 2027 by coach to the airport and is expected to return on Friday 16 July 2027.

Although not a compulsory part of the curriculum, this trip will provide students an opportunity to explore Iceland and its spectacular landscape.

Example itinerary (may be subject to change)

Day 1

Transfer to the airport from Sir Thomas Wharton Academy.

Flight from a UK airport to Reykjavik.

Arrive at Reykjavik, board coach and depart for excursion Coach excursion to Reykjanes Peninsula (inc Stamper Craters, Gunnhver Hot Springs and the Reykjanes Lighthouse).

Arrive at accommodation, group to check in Evening meal at accommodation and overnight stay.

Day 2

Breakfast at accommodation.

Full day coach excursion to The Golden Circle (inc Thingvellir National Park, Strokkur Geysir and Gullfoss Waterfall).

Packed lunches will be provided.

Visit to The Secret Lagoon

Evening meal at accommodation and overnight stay.

Day 3

Breakfast at accommodation.

Full day coach excursion to The South Shore (inc Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss falls, as well as Solheimajokull Glacier).

Packed lunches will be provided.

Visit to Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach.

Evening meal at accommodation and overnight stay.

Day 4

Breakfast at accommodation.

Self-led visit to the Perlan Interactive Nature Museum.

Packed lunches will be provided.

Free time in Reykjavik - optional visits to Hallgrímskirkja Church and City Hall.

VR Experience at Flyover Iceland.

Evening meal at accommodation and overnight stay.

Day 5



Breakfast at accommodation.
Check out and room inspections.
Coach transfer to airport.
Flight from Reykjavik to UK.
Transfer Sir Thomas Wharton Academy.

The total cost of the visit is £1450 and is fully inclusive of all travel, excursions and food. Additional costs to consider will be money for any gifts/souvenir.

By making the initial payment, you are giving consent for your child to take part on this visit and agreeing to the non-refundable payment plan below:

Initial payment: £150 due Monday 30 March 2026
Remaining deposit balance to tour operator: £200 due by Monday 27 April 2026
Interim payment 1: £325 due by Monday 6 July 2026
Interim payment 2: £325 due by Monday 14 September 2026
Interim payment 3: £325 due by Monday 23 November 2026
Interim payment 4: £125 due Monday 1 February 2027
